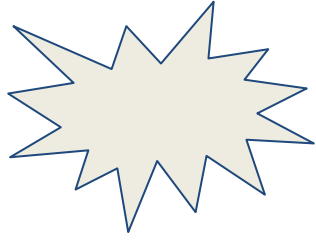

 - The word of the day is tusi.
- O le ā le uiga o tusi?
 - What is the meaning of tusi?
- O lona uiga o “book”
 - It’s meaning is “book”

Past	Present	Future
Na - Past tense, action complete	E- Habitual, constant state	O le'a- Future
Sa- Past tense, action incomplete	te- Habitual, constant state (USED WITH PRONOUNS)

	O lo'o- Continuous action

le- the (O le tusi) - specific, singular

se- a (O se tusi) - nonspecific, singular

lau- your (O lau tusi) - specific, singular

sau- your (O sau tusi) - nonspecific, singular

E iai sau uati? - Do you have a watch (of yours)?

Te

- Used only with Pronouns

• Ou te - I

• E te - You

• Na te - her/him/it

• Ma te -We both (exclusive)

• Ta te -We both (Inclusive)

• Lua te -You both

• La te -They both

• Matou te- We (3+ ex)

• Tatou te- We (3+ inc)

• Tou te- You (3+)

• Latou te- They (3+)

Samoan locations

To identify the location of an object or where an action happens, we use the following indicators (prepositions)

i: common nouns (fale, ta'avale, laulau,)

‘Ua moe le pepe i le moega

Ou te alofa i le teine.

E alu Kelisa i le fale.

Add Direction to a Location Phrase?

Pattern: Preposition + location + Noun

Examples:

- i luga o _____ above/on top of
- i lalo o _____ below/beneath of
- i fafo o _____ outside of
- i totonu o _____ Inside of
- i tua o _____ behind/in back of
- i luma o _____ in front of

Ofea (fea): Where

Ofea le peni

Simple Answer: i lalo o le kesi/laulau
