- Ma te -We both (exclusive)

- Ta te -We both (Inclusive)

- Lua te -You both

- La te -They both

- Matou te- We (3+ ex)

- Tatou te- We (3+ inc)

- Tou te- You (3+)

- Latou te- They (3+)

Samoan locations

To identify the location of an object or where an action happens, we use the following indicators (prepositions)

i: common nouns (fale, ta'avale, laulau,)

‘Ua moe le pepe i le moega

Ou te alofa i le teine.

E alu Kelisa i le fale.

Pattern: Preposition + location + Noun

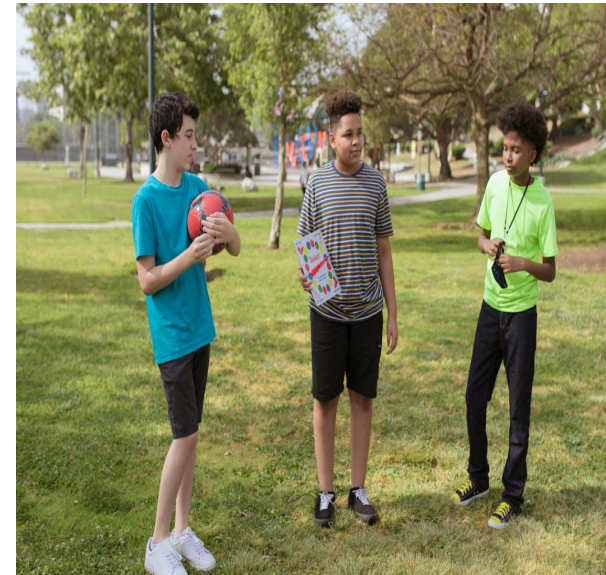
